### University fees

For all students registered with Durham University there is an annual university fee. For students who are members of the Anglican church there may be a reduction available to the university fee if students fit certain criteria. The current university fee for individual students ranges from £288 to £480. Further information on this is available on request.

### Payment

- Each year our fees increase slightly. Students pay the fee in year of entry. If a place is deferred, the fee is the fee in the year study starts.
- Fees can be paid by the student, or a support organisation, by electronic payment, credit card or cheque. Electronic methods are more easily tracked.
- For full courses we take a non-refundable deposit, which goes towards course fees. Early bird deposit, paid before 15 July, is £100. Deposit paid after 15 July is £150.
- For all awards, fees can be paid upfront with one lump sum or by standing order (dividing costs over the number of months a student is with us). Fees must be paid to keep pace with studies and all fees paid by the end of the course to enable students to complete and/or graduate.
- Students signing up for modules pay the fee for a module in the academic year it is taken.
- We do not take a deposit for modules.
- Modules must be paid for in advance.
