NB these fees are for the whole course, e.g. BA, normally over three years, so £3,200 per year = £9,600 for the full BA (plus annual university fee); MA, normally over three years, so £2,200 per year = £6,600 for the full MA (plus annual university fee). **If you take longer than the average length of time the price remains the same.** The **only extra fee**, payable for each year of study, is the university fee (see below).

University fees

For all students registered with Durham University there is an annual university fee.

- Total independent full-time annual university fee for 2025–26 is £514
- Total part time (MA) annual university fee for 2025–26 is £302

Payment

- Each year our fees increase slightly. Students pay the fee in year of entry. If a place is deferred, the fee is the fee in the year study starts.
- Fees can be paid by the student, or a support organisation, by electronic payment, credit card or cheque. Electronic methods are more easily tracked.
- For full courses we take a non-refundable deposit, which goes towards course fees. Early bird deposit, paid by 31 July – £150. Deposit paid from 1 August – £250.
- Fees can be paid upfront with one lump sum or by standing order (dividing costs over the number of months a student is with us) for all awards. Fees must be paid to keep pace with studies and all fees paid by the end of the course to enable students to complete and/or graduate.
- Students signing up for modules pay the fee for a module in the academic year it is taken.
- We do not take deposit for modules.
- Modules must be paid for in advance.
